Review of ASC meeting minutes

Dissertation award recipients

- Deadline at the end of March
- Decided at ASC to have two separate award cycles:
 - 1st deadline- March 31st;
 - 2nd deadline- fall 2015
- Multiple cycles, but only one award per person
- Total of \$9,000 for each scholarship period
- Intended for dissertation student and maximum award of \$3,000
- Looking for reviewers of these proposals
 - Email Pauline Brennan if you are interested in being a reviewer
 - Need to evaluate cost effectiveness of proposals so students should work with faculty to prepare the most effective applications
- Previous award cycle- 5 awards with approximately 12 applicants
- Consider placing the scholarship award in "The Criminologist" and potentially the ACJS dissemination
